



Re-Opening East Hartford Public Schools

Over the last two weeks East Hartford Public Schools has offered Town Hall Meetings to discuss the re-opening our district. Connections with Staff — Will my child get regular face time with teachers online? Children Wearing Masks — How will you enforce this? What will the protocols be for children who cannot wear a mask?
